Last P&C meeting – discussion items

The last meeting was on 17 March. The President's report for 2013-14 is on the P&C website and has been reproduced in *Whispers*. Some items discussed were:

- ❑ the new playground – all were happy with progress; the second stage can commence and funding is secured
- ❑ available funds – there are sufficient funds to be able to contribute significantly towards a number of School initiatives this year and next
- ❑ the multi-cultural wall at the back of the police station - the P&C will likely fund the cost of paint and a design proposal is forthcoming
- ❑ Mr Nogher will be co-ordinating funding requests to be made by the School of the P&C. These will be submitted in time for discussion at the next meeting (on 19 May) regarding possible expenditure on computers, library upgrade, for example
- ❑ The same DJ as last year has been booked for the Halloween disco, which is locked in for Saturday, 1 November in the School hall.
