UNIFORM SHOP COORDIATOR

The P&C is looking for someone who can spare a little time each week to be our Uniform Shop Coordinator. The role involves:

- opening up the uniform shop once a week for sales (approx. 30-45min). The day and time of opening is up to the volunteer.

- fulfilling order forms from students (approx. 30-45min weekly)
- ordering new stock when supply runs low
- banking takings
- twice-yearly stocktakes
